In areas of high humidity where solid sheathing is required:

Following are 4 different suggested methods of application to increase longevity:




Figure 23a: Certi-Last® shake application

- Apply Certi-Last pressure-impregnated treated shakes or shingles directly to the sheathing. (Figure 23a)
- Apply vertical strips over the sheathing in alignment with the rafters below, then place horizontal furring strips on top of the vertical boards. (See Figure 23b).
- Apply horizontal furring strips to the deck, spaced at the exposure of the product.
- A continuous ventilation product may be used beneath the Certi-label roofing material (See Figure 23c).

Note: Good ventilation is essential. Ridge and soffit vents are recommended.

(Option 1 depicted)




Figure 23b: Vertical Strips Over Solid Sheathing Application (Option 2 Depicted)




Figure 23c: Continuous Ventilation Product
